Draft Plan 2022

GWL participated in

- March 22 - UN CSW66 meetings in New York via online meetings
- 21 Oct 22 - Rotterdam School of Management - Leadership Conference
- 18 Nov 22 - ECWO - Women in Leadership Conference : speaker 2x
- 18 May 22 - Genera Network at TU Delft Live : speaker 1x
- GWL has applied for a grant of 15,000 euros from VMTC Motary for the implementation of the Silent Leaders project, which has unfortunately not been awarded
- The planned events on March 8 International Women's Day and May 21 International Diversity Day have not been carried out due to the workload of the board members
- The implementation of Social Media (including blog) has been completed.
- The Dutch Women's Council (NVR) has approached GWL for a cooperation
 - Claudia Hopman participated in the Appointment and Advisory Committee (BAC) for the appointment of the annual UN VP of the Netherlands
 - She also participated as a jury member for the final selection for 2023
 - Subsequently, the role of secretary in the board was discussed. However, this role was not accepted because NVR requires more attention at the moment than Claudia / GWL can offer.
